A practical course in Iceland

Rocks from Field to Lab

Spring 2025
4 ECTS

This intensive “field to lab” study programme includes a short stay in Iceland with other Aurora students. The course is organised by and open to students from the University of Iceland, the University of Naples Federico II, and the University of Innsbruck.

The course offers **geology students** an opportunity to study igneous, sedimentary and metamorphic rocks in theory, the field and in the laboratory. The focus is on the Mid-Oceanic-Ridge (MOR) environment in Iceland including the on-going eruptions.

The course is an **Erasmus+ Blended Intensive Programme (BIP)**, featuring a series of online seminars to be followed by a **field trip to Iceland along with lab work**.

2nd or 3rd year Bachelor students and 1st year Master students are eligible to apply.
