

## A ZULU BRIDE'S TROUSSEAU.

1 and 2. Headgear. 3. Small beadwork ornament worn round neck. 4. Bead snuff-box. 5. Rolls of beads worn round the neck or loins. 6. Bead necklaces. 7 String of beads worn over the shoulder and under the arm. 8. Ornament worn on the breast. 9. Girdle of beads. 10. Rope of beads worn round the wrists and foot-joints. 11. Small apron of bead work, the size of one's hand, the only garment of little girls. 12. A kilt consisting of a bead apron and fringe. 13. Cotton shawl, bordered with beads and fringe. 14. Snuff-boxes trimmed with beads.
